

Only a few days left to Save Cannon Hill

As you are probably aware, proposals exist to extract up to 2.5 million tonnes of sand from the Forrestry Commission Plantation at Cannon Hill over the next 25 years or so, creating a quarry which could come to within 25 metres of properties bordering the plantation. It would entail the removal of 40 lorry loads per day of sand from the site through the Uddens Drive entrance; small contractors and builders would gain access through Cannon Hill Road opposite Colehill First School.

Responses to the proposals must arrive by 3 pm on 12 December
